Okotoks Minor Hockey is committed to providing an environment in which all individuals – players, bench staff, spectators and game officials – are treated with respect.

It has recently come to my attention that certain individuals and groups within OMHA have been abusing our game officials and conducting themselves in a manner that is not consistent with the values or Code of Conduct of Okotoks Minor Hockey or Hockey Alberta.

Be advised:

Insulting language or gestures towards the referee in the arena is just as unacceptable as it would be on the street or in the grocery store. The context of hockey does not change what is appropriate or what should be tolerated, and our children should not be led to believe otherwise.

As role models to these young players, it is everyone's responsibility to demonstrate dignity and respect, no matter what the venue.

Members and participants shall not engage in any activity or behaviour that is not consistent with the values of fairness, integrity and mutual respect. As per the VP of Programs letter we have advised our Directors to notify all referees that any further incidents from spectators will result in the immediate suspension of game play until the referee has removed the spectator in violation of the Code of Conduct. The OMHA Game in Conduct Volunteers and Executive board have already received numerous complaints and issues derived from behavioral issues at the Rink.

Players, coaches and officials make mistakes. Hockey is a game played, coached and officiated by humans. Players have the greatest opportunity through the course of a game to influence it's outcome more than any referee who just 'blew' a call ever will.

Hockey is a game, let's keep it fun for everyone.

The two NHL sized arenas will now be known as the Pason Centennial "GREEN" and "GOLD" arenas. The original arena will be the GREEN arena and the new arena will be the GOLD arena. Isn't that much better than Pason #1 and Pason #2!!

There will be 3 new multi-purpose rooms in the expanded facility and will be available to rent starting March 1st (bookings will not be taken until February 1st)

Opening hours of the Leisure Ice Arena will be 9:00 am – 9:00 p.m. Flood times will vary depending on other activities in the building and the amount of use on the ice surface. All skating will be free of charge and is not rentable. Please note that this surface is for leisure skating only. Full hockey equipment is not permitted, hockey practices/warm-ups and figure skating is not allowed and users will lose their regular ice times if abused in any way.

The Alberta Gaming & Liquor Commission has scheduled a Gaming Information for Charitable Groups (GAIN) combined session near you! The session is Tuesday February 6th, 2018, at the Best Western Plus Okotoks Inn & Suites, 100 Southbank Road, Okotoks at 9am-1pm.

This session is for all charitable groups who have a gaming licence or who would like to learn how to get a gaming licence and who would like more information on how gaming funds may be used. Examples of groups would be:

- · Museum Society, Historical Society, Senior Clubs and Church Organizations
- School Education Associations and Sports groups curling, soccer, hockey, skating, golf

The Alberta Gaming and Liquor Commission facilitator will cover the following topics:

- Policies around the use of gaming proceeds and how to get approvals (examples of forms). New Forms & policies for donations
